Dear Mr. Prime Minister.

The atrocities and the massacre of the Islamic regime in Iran, which involves the killing of unarmed protester, the slaughtering of the innocent people, employing the use of drones and chemical weapons against their own civilian, amounts to genocide.

Regime enacted a total communications blackout to conceal their savage actions in silence and obscurity of the free world. By this behavior, it is evident that the rulers in Iran have forfeited all political, moral, and legal legitimacy, which for years has the free world granted to them.

The actions of the Islamic regime against the national Iranian revolution, resulting in the deaths of tens of thousands of innocent people, constitute a clear example of crimes against humanity and a flagrant violation of all principles of international law and human rights.

Today, the nations of the world widely recognize the Islamic regime as entirely discredited and devoid of legitimacy on the international stage. Aware of this truth, any renewed efforts by states to maintain political relations under the pretext of "diplomacy"—whether through negotiations, receptions, or meetings with individuals affiliated with this regime, including dispatched delegations, ambassadors, representatives, agents, or cultural attachés—are tantamount to supporting the perpetrators and murderers of the Iranian people. Such practices must cease immediately and without exception!

Continuing dialogue and engagement with such a regime are neither neutrality nor diplomacy; rather, it constitutes complicity in the perpetuation of crimes against humanity.

The free world cannot simultaneously claim to defend human rights while providing a platform to representatives of a regime engaged in genocidal policies, thereby facilitating their propaganda, or continuing to grant them diplomatic protection and credibility.

We demand the immediate expulsion of ambassadors of the inhumane regime ruling Iran and the closure of its official representations in all European countries.

Today, before the watchful eyes of the international community, European governments have a duty to stand alongside the Iranian people and recognize the clearly expressed the will of Iranians, who seek an end to this anti-human regime and a return to genuine national sovereignty.

Simultaneously, recognizing Prince Reza Pahlavi as the leader of the Iranian national revolution today represents a clear response to the historic and public demand of the Iranian people, and a step toward supporting a transition to freedom, stability, and the rule of law.

The eyes of the Iranian people and the nations of the world are upon you.
